

## Student Status—What It Means

The following table lists possible student test statuses and actions you can select on the **Action** drop-down list.

**Tip:** If you want to select all students with the same test status, use the **Select Status** drop-down list.

**Student Testing Status**

Status	Description
<b>Awaiting Student</b>	Ready for student to sign in.  <b>Note:</b> This status appears whenever you start a testing session, even for students who have a suspended test.
<b>Completed</b>	Student finished.  If needed, you can give another test using <b>Select Action &gt; Test Again</b> .
<b>Confirmed</b>	Ready for student to click <b>Start Test</b> .
<b>Paused</b>	Proctor has paused the student's test.
<b>Suspended</b>	Proctor has suspended the student test (or it was paused but automatically suspended after 25 minutes).  <b>Note:</b> After you end a testing session, this status reverts to Awaiting Student.
<b>Terminated</b>	Proctor has terminated the student test (the test results are deleted from the student's record and the test cannot be continued).
<b>Testing</b>	Student's test has started.
<b>To Be Confirmed</b>	Student signed in and is waiting for the proctor to confirm the student.  <b>Tip:</b> If the student does not have the correct name and test, select <b>Do Not Confirm</b> and help the student.
