

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2018-19

Eligibility and Qualifications

The basic qualifications for all scholarships are listed below. Additional eligibility requirements specific to each scholarship and an explanation of the criteria used in making the awards are indicated with the description of individual scholarships.

1. You must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (including transfer credits).
2. Submit the Free Application of Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (where applicable).
3. You must be admitted to the School of Education or meet all requirements for admission.
4. In addition, the scholarship committee will base its decisions on your response to the questions on the front, and the information listed on your résumé.
5. You must be registered for at least six credits each semester you receive your scholarship (undergraduate/post baccalaureate only).

Application Process

Scholarships are awarded for the 2018-19 academic year.

Scholarship award winners will be announced in late spring 2018.

Following are the steps required to complete the application process:

- Complete the application form. The committee will determine what scholarships you may be eligible for.
- Answer the essay questions, located on the application form.
- Documents must be submitted electronically as one email to soeinfo@uwm.edu. Please write "Scholarship Application" in the subject line. No paper applications will be accepted.
